

INFORMED CONSENT FOR VERSED (MIDAZOLAM)

Information for parents and guardians about your child's sedation:

- a) Versed can be give orally or nasally depending on cooperation.
- b) Please arrive 30 minutes prior to the appointment time.
- c) When given orally, it is mixed with a flavouring agent, such as chocolate syrup, or Children's Tylenol.
- d) Meals: The patient can have a light meal up to four (4) hours prior to the appointment (Example: toast and clear juice) (NOT grapefruit juice).
- e) Please let Dr. Piracha know if any other medication has been given.
- f) Versed has the following effects on children:
 - Drowsiness—this will last from 2-4 hours after the appointment. Please watch your child because his/her stability will not be normal for this period of time.
 - Amnesic effect—most children will forget about the dental procedures due to the medication.
 - Vomiting—this may occur 1-2 hours after the dental appointment.
 - Daydreams--Some parents report that their children have daydreams during the appointment.
 - A very small number of children get overexcited from the medication, if this occurs, it may not be possible to complete the planned procedure
